I wanted to drop you an update on our October mission to Berlin.

The flight is booked; on 20 October 2019 we depart Luton at 19.35pm and land in Berlin Schoenefeld at 22.25pm, German time.

We will be flying back from Berlin on 24 October 2019 at 09.55am, landing in Luton at 10.50am, UK time.

I will be in touch with some ideas about getting to and from Luton nearer the time.

I have also booked the hotel/hostel, which is a place I have stayed in before and which is fantastic and in an amazing location –

The Circus Hostel (<https://www.circus-berlin.de/hostel/>).

It is in Mitte, the heart of Berlin, very near Hackescher Markt. It is a wonderful district known for cutting edge fashion and hipsters and in mid-October there will be sixteen more hepcats there than normal. I have also booked us their 'legendary' breakfast each morning, which is part of the £400. We will forage for grubs and berries for lunch and dinner as we prowl the urban jungle. I'll advise on costs later, but Berlin is relatively cheap.

My next step is to start booking us into attractions before Brexit comes and removes student deals. I'll be in touch before the end of term, but I am thinking Norman Foster's Reichstag, some of the museums on Museum Insel, the Sony Centre and maybe the DDR Museum. There will also be A LOT of walking – it is a city which can only be known on foot and it rewards the effort immeasurably.
