### Transport (outward & inward journey, and coach journeys for local visits)

I understand that.....

1. I must remain seated with my seatbelt fastened at all times on the coach.
2. I must listen and follow instructions from the coach driver and staff at all times.
3. When we stop for a break, I must listen to instructions carefully.
4. I must tidy off any rubbish on the coach before getting off.
5. I must remain with my allocated member of staff unless instructed otherwise.
6. I must remain with a group of 3 to 4 pupils at all times when unsupervised.
7. I must arrive on time at the meeting point before re-joining the coach with the group.

### At the accommodation

I understand that.....

1. I must show respect at all times to the hotel staff and other visitors.
2. I must listen to and follow instructions from the hotel staff and Pitsford School teachers.
3. I must ask for clarification if unsure of the instructions.
4. I must remain in my allocated room after 9pm or as instructed by staff.
5. I must behave in an orderly fashion around the premises and all shared areas.
6. At mealtimes I must behave sensibly at all times and remain seated until I am dismissed.
7. When given free time, I must remain within the area allocated to our group.

### During local visits

I understand that.....

1. I must remain seated, with my seatbelt fastened and behave sensibly at all times on the coach.
2. I must listen to instructions carefully and remain within my allocated group and member of staff at all times.
3. If given free time, I must remain in my allocated group of 3 or 4 pupils.
4. I must behave sensibly in shops and around the places I am visiting.
5. I mustn't purchase any unauthorised or inappropriate goods such as laser pens, fireworks, replica BB guns, knives, or any other products which staff instruct pupils not to buy whilst in France.
