Dear Parents

I am writing to you again in light of the Prime Minister's press conference on Monday 16th March, as a few of his statements refer directly to school.

Most relevantly, he noted that anyone in a house with someone who has symptoms of a coronavirus (in particular a new, persistent cough and / or a high temperature) should stay at home for 14 days.

Thus, if you, or any of your household are exhibiting symptoms which require self-isolation then your children must also stay away from school for the mandated 14 days, even if they are asymptomatic.
