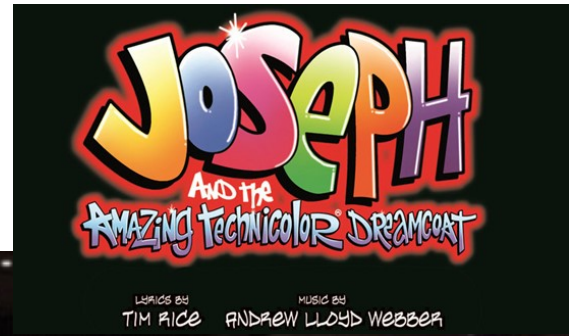

- Art News -

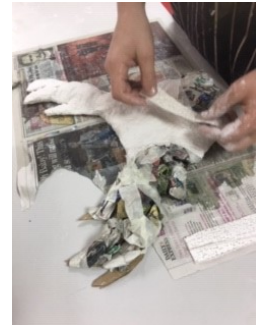

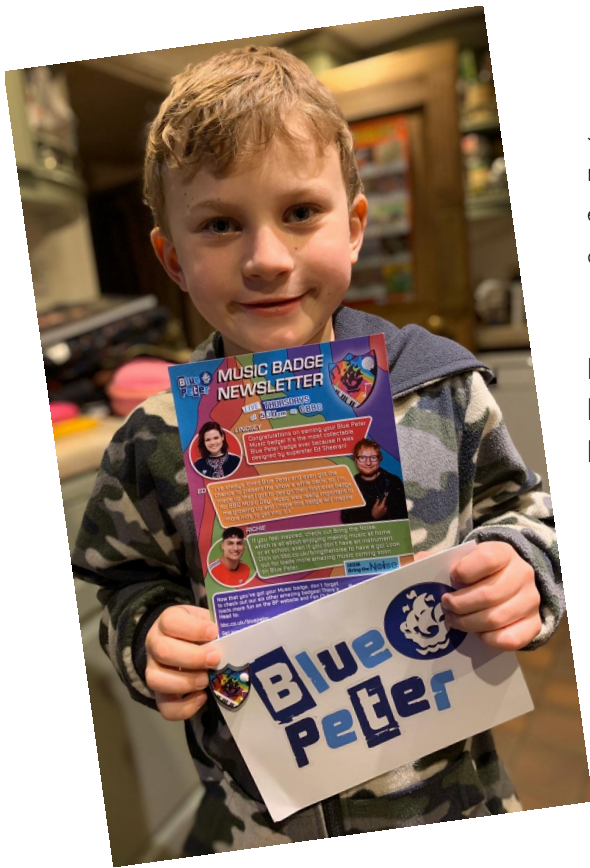
- Senior School Fun Run -
